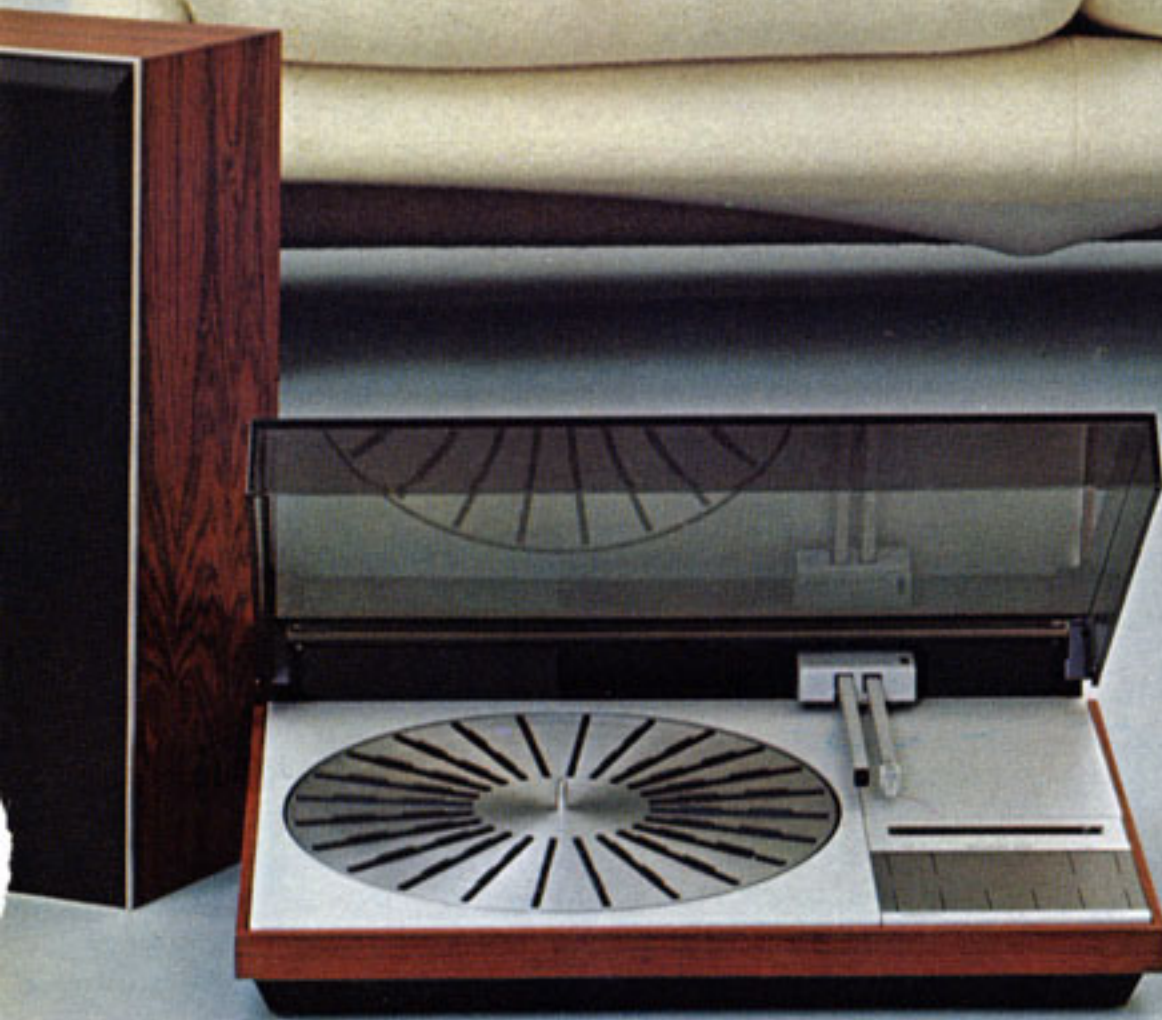


The Maralunga tweed couch (below) was designed by Vico Magistretti for Cassina of Milan, Italy. The judges found that the couch is as comfortable as it looks. The back cushions contain a concealed steel armature so that they can be raised from the folded position shown here to form a high back for resting the head. \$1,780.



Cedric Hartman of Omaha, Nebraska, is the designer and manufacturer of this severe, yet sumptuous, lamp (above). The shade and base are of polished, unlacquered brass; the stem is mirror-finished stainless steel. Hartman's company produces several variations of this lamp to order.
